WHAT NOT TO BRING

Camp is something special. One of the ways we keep it that way is by preserving freedom from certain things when we gather together. Please help us protect the magic of camp by leaving these things at home:

- Any mobile data-capable device, including cameras (cell phones are securely stored until the end of the session)
- Computers, tablets, gaming devices, + other electronics
- Fireworks, lighters, or anything that ignites
- Non-prescription drugs or chemical substances (all prescription medication is stored in the Wellness Center)
- Weapons of any kind, including pocket knives
- Skateboards + bikes
- Pets (except Certified Service Animals - please call to discuss this with a Director)
- Alcohol or tobacco in any form, including vapes
- Valuables + expensive jewelry
- Additional food (except when needed for dietary reasons - please call to discuss this with a Director)
- Money, except what is deposited into Campers' Bank at check-in

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
